Three or four cars had once again been parked on the bend in Preston Road beside Station Close causing a danger to drivers attempting to pass the parked vehicles. As this was on a Wednesday it was thought that it might be people attending the Forest School and efforts would be made to warn of the dangers and suggest alternative, safer, places to park.
