



# The Jane Bellward Award

The Jane Bellward award has been created by the Parish Council to recognise these young people and is an opportunity for the community to say thank you.

Examples of voluntary service include:

- Being a young caregiver
- Regular litter picking
- Being a good neighbour

## Who can be nominated?

- Must be resident in Lavenham Parish
- If an individual, must be currently of school age (4 year old up to 18)
- If a group/ club, must be for young persons aged under 18

## Who can nominate?

Anyone can be a nominee including a family member.

## How to nominate:

Nominations will be made using a dedicated paper nomination form. These must be posted by the closing date into the post box at the Parish Office.
